**NORTH AURORA, IL**—The North Aurora Police Department is investigating a strong arm robbery that occurred on Saturday, Oct. 29<sup>th</sup>, 2011 at approximately 2:03 pm at Woodman's Market, 151 Hansen Blvd.

Two employees were transporting an undetermined amount of currency from the main Woodman's store to the Gas and Lube station on foot. After crossing through the parking lot, a silver four door vehicle possibly a 2011 or 2012 Hyundai Sonata or Toyota Camry pulled up behind them and a black male passenger exited. He struck one of the employees from behind and grabbed the money.

The vehicle was being driven by a second black male. Both wore dark clothing during the robbery. The vehicle left the scene southbound on Orchard Rd. The suspects' vehicle had a partial plate of 64245.

The employee was treated by medics and released on scene.

**UPDATE**

**NORTH AURORA, IL**—The North Aurora Police Department continues to investigate the Strong Arm Robbery that occurred at Woodman's Market, 151 Hansen Blvd. on Saturday, Oct. 29<sup>th</sup>, 2011 at approximately 2:03 p.m.

Investigators have determined that the suspect vehicle is in fact a 2011 or 2012 Hyundai Sonata 4 door and that the suspects were in the parking lot prior to the robbery. It is likely that someone saw the suspects before, during, or after the robbery and witness accounts would be useful to the investigation.

The pictures below are of a similar vehicle, but are NOT the suspect vehicle.



Investigators have also determined that the license displayed on the suspect vehicle during the robbery was stolen from another similar-looking Hyundai Sonata (charcoal color, not silver). The license plate is a Firefighters Memorial plate of 64245, which is pictured below. The stolen plate is a back plate and would have a State of Illinois sticker with an expiration date of 9/2012.

If anyone spots the above plate on or off of a vehicle, please notify your local police by calling 911 right away. Do not approach the offenders or put yourself in danger.

Finally, the North Aurora Police Department would like to stress that the offenders targeted Woodman's Market, not random customers. The North Aurora Police Department does not believe that customers are at risk of a random attack.

Investigators would be interested in speaking with anyone who may have seen the suspects or suspect vehicle in the parking lot between 1:00 p.m. and 2:03 p.m. or who may have seen the suspects fleeing the scene between 2:03 p.m. and 2:30 p.m. The suspects left the scene southbound on Hansen Blvd., westbound on Orchard Gateway, and then southbound on Orchard Rd. They may have been driving recklessly, such as speeding, cutting off other vehicles, and/or running red lights. No piece of information is too small.

This incident remains under investigation by the North Aurora Police Department and those with information concerning this crime have three options to help:
