

## **Chapter 10.20 PARKING**

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### **10.20.010 Restricted parking along portions of Illinois State Route 31 (Lincolnway) and State Route 56 (State Street) within North Aurora.**

- A. Parking shall not be permitted along:
1. The south side of State Street from the intersection of Lincolnway east to the village parking lot;
  2. The north and south side of State Street west from the intersection of Lincolnway and State Street to the alley;
  3. Both sides of Lincolnway in the Village of North Aurora.
- B. Parking along the north side of State Street from the intersection of Lincolnway and State Street east to the alley is limited to parallel parking only.
- C. Motor vehicular parking shall not be permitted along South Lincolnway (Illinois State Route 31) from the Illinois state toll highway to Sullivan Road, all within the village limits.
- D. Motor vehicular parking shall be limited to designated areas along Illinois State Route 56 between the eastern edge of the mill race bridge to the western edge of the Fox River bridge all within the village limits.
- E. The village may prohibit future parking at such locations on or immediately adjacent to Illinois State Routes 56 and 31 in the project area as may be determined and directed by the state of Illinois to be necessary to insure the free flow of traffic and safety to the motoring public.
- F. The village clerk is authorized and directed to attach a copy of the ordinances codified in this section to the Agreement by and between the State of Illinois and the Village of North Aurora. (Ord. 97-37 §§ 1--3; Ord. 94-2 § 1; Ord. 87-8 §§ 1, 2)

### **10.20.020 Parking near Goodwin Elementary School.**

- A. There shall be no stopping, standing or parking on Harmony Drive from the point thirty-six (36) feet west of the intersection between Harmony Drive and Cypress Drive east along Harmony Drive to the point ninety-six (96) feet east of the intersection at Harmony Drive and Poplar Place during school days between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. and between the hours of 1:00 p.m. and 3:00 p.m.
- B. There shall be no stopping, standing or parking on Poplar Place from the intersection at Poplar Place and Harmony Drive south along Poplar Place to the point that is thirty-two (32) feet south of the apron to the south entrance to the school

drive through during school days between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.

C. There shall be no stopping, standing or parking on Cypress Drive from the intersection at Cypress Drive and Harmony Drive north along Cypress Drive for a distance of ninety-one (91) feet during school days between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. (Ord. 07-08-27-02 § 2; Ord. 05-02-14-06 § 2; Ord. 98-3 § 2; Ord. 97-30 §§ 1—5)

### **10.20.030 No parking areas.**

A. No parking shall be allowed along and adjacent to the improvements and the approaches to those improvements for a distance of two hundred eighty (280) feet from the mid point of the intersection on any property lying within the corporate limits of the village along Hart and Mitchell Roads.

B. No parking shall be allowed along and immediately adjacent to Route 56 (also known as Butterfield Road) from and including the State Street Bridge and continuing west to the boundary of the Village corporate limits, including the intersection at Hart/Mitchell Road.

C. No parking shall be allowed on the west side of Grant Street from State Street to the north property line of 46 Grant Street.

D. No parking shall be allowed on the east side and the west side of Grant Street for the first one hundred ninety (190) feet from the intersection of State Street on the north end of Grant Street.

E. A stop sign shall be placed at the south end of Grant Street before the bend in the street, the hill and the railroad tracks. Parking shall be prohibited on both sides of the street for the first one hundred seventy (170) feet from this stop sign.

F. No parking shall be allowed on the residence side of Hawksley Lane from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. from April 1 to August 1.

G. No parking shall be allowed on that portion of White Oak Drive stretching from Hartsburg Lane to Waterford Road.

H. No parking shall be allowed on either the north or south side of Oak Street from Randall Road to Orchard Road.

I. No parking shall be allowed along designated state routes within the village except as provided by this chapter:

1. On compacted areas created for parking in conjunction with a business or residence; or

2. As required in an emergency, in which case the vehicle must be removed within a twenty-four (24) hour period.

J. No parking shall be allowed on the east side of Alder Drive from the north end of Alder Drive to the intersection of Alder Drive and Airport Road.

K. No parking shall be allowed on the north side of Ice Cream Drive from the intersection of Randall Road and Ice Cream Drive to the intersection of Alder Drive and Ice Cream Drive.

L. The village administrator and the chief of police are authorized and empowered to take whatever steps they deem are necessary to enforce the prohibition of parking in the areas identified above including, but not necessarily limited to, the posting of no parking signs, the issuance of tickets for violations, the prosecution of violations and any other actions that are reasonable and necessary for the enforcement of this chapter.

M. Parking on the north side of East State Street from the intersection at Route 25 to the interaction with Stone Avenue is hereby prohibited at all times. (Ord. 05-11-14-01 § 2; Ord. 05-02-14-05 § 2; Ord. 03-04-14-02; 03-01-13-01; 02-12-09-02; 02-06-24-03; Ord. 99-05-24-02 §§ 2—4)

### **10.20.040 Parking near Schneider Elementary School.**

The following areas are declared no parking zones on days when school is in session from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.:

A. On the east side of Banbury Road, from the northeast corner of the intersection at Chestnut Street and Banbury Road continuing north to the south boundary line of the Maplewood Nursing Home property.

B. On Flagstone Court from the east side property line of 419 Flagstone Court west to Banbury Road and from the east side property line of 418 Flagstone Court west to Banbury Road.

- C. On the north side of Dee Road, from the intersection at Dee Road and Banbury Road west to the east side of the drive into the Schneider School front entrance.
- D. On the south side of Dee Road, from the intersection at Dee Road and Banbury Road west to a distance one hundred seventy (170) feet from the intersection of Dee Road and Banbury Road.
- E. The police chief is directed and authorized to have signs posted in appropriate places along the no parking zones described in this section that shall read, "NO PARKING DURING SCHOOL DAYS 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.," and to enforce the parking restrictions by any and all means available for parking and traffic violations generally. ### **10.20.050 Parking near Fearn Elementary School.**

- A. The following area hereby declared a no parking zone on days when school is in session from 7:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. and from 1:30 p.m. to 2:30 p.m.:
- B. On the south side of Hartsburg Lane, from the intersection with Hawksley Lane west into the cul-de-sac, including all of the cul-de-sac.
- C. The police chief is hereby directed and authorized to have signs posted in appropriate places along the no parking zone described in subsection B of this section that shall read, "NO PARKING DURING SCHOOL DAYS 7:30 A.M. TO 8:30 A.M. AND 1:30 P.M. TO 2:30 P.M.," and to enforce the parking restrictions by any and all means available for parking and traffic violations generally (Ord. 05-10-24-03 § 2)

### **10.20.060 Parking during or after a snowfall.**

- A. It is unlawful for any person to park a motor vehicle or, if parked, to allow a motor vehicle to remain parked or standing in any public street or alley during or after a snowfall in which there is an accumulation of two inches of snow or more. This prohibition shall remain in effect until such time as the street or alley has been plowed or the snow has been removed therefrom. A village street shall not be deemed to have been plowed until the lane of traffic nearest the curb has been plowed or the snow has been removed therefrom and pushed to within eight inches from the curb.
- B. Whenever a vehicle is parked in violation of this section, and where such vehicle constitutes an obstruction to traffic, interferes with the use of streets or in any manner creates a dangerous or unsafe condition, such vehicle is declared a nuisance and a hazard to public safety, and a police officer or code enforcement officer of the village may cause the removal of such vehicle to a public garage or other place of safety during snow removal operations of the village on such streets, and the expense of such removal and storage in a public garage shall be paid by the owner or operator of the vehicle, in addition to any other penalties imposed by this section.
- C. The removal of snow from public streets in the village of North Aurora shall be performed only by village employees and other persons specifically employed and/or directed by the village to perform such service. Removal of snow from village streets by any other person is prohibited. Notwithstanding the foregoing language to the contrary, this section is not intended to prohibit individual homeowners from removing snow from in front of their mail boxes in order to make them accessible by mail carriers from the street as long as no other provision of this section is violated in so doing.
- D. No person shall dump, pile, push, or otherwise place snow at or near a street intersection so as to violate the line of sight easement (illustrated in Exhibit 1 attached to the ordinance codified in this section) as provided in the village of North Aurora subdivision control ordinance, Article III, Section 3-6, Subsection F, which provides that no obstructions shall be placed in the line-of-sight easement which exceeds three feet above the centerline grade. Any person who dumps, pushes, piles or otherwise places snow in the line-of-sight easement and allows it to remain after ceasing the activity, or who directs, causes or allows snow to be dumped, piled, pushed or otherwise placed in the line-of-sight easement and allows it to remain after the activity ceases, shall be in violation of this section.
- E. A fine of no less than fifty dollars (\$50.00) and no more than seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00) shall be imposed for

each violation of this section, each day that a violation continues being considered a separate violation. In addition to, or in place of, a fine, this section may be enforced by court proceeding for injunction or any other remedy available by ordinance, by statute, or by law. This section shall be enforced by the village police department, code enforcement officer, designee of the village board, or any other individual with code enforcement authority.
